



KCSD 2021-2022 MASK MANDATE

1. Masks are mandatory throughout the district regardless of vaccination status.
2. Daily/routine temperature checks are no longer required.
3. Continuation of classroom wipe-downs between classes or activities that require students to move to different desk/table/area/classroom.
 - a. Teachers will wipe-down for Pre-K through grade 6.
 - b. Students will wipe-down for grades 7-12.
4. Continuation of daily fogging.
5. Students will have assigned seating in all classes in an effort to assist with contact tracing if/when necessary.
6. Students will eat breakfast and lunch in the cafeteria, but prolonged sitting will not be allowed.
7. School visitors will not be allowed to enter the building unless the school has called them in.
8. Extra-curricular activities, such as athletics, will require participants to be vaccinated.
9. Vaccinated district employees must provide a copy of their vaccination card to the principal/administrator. The principal/administrator will submit the confidential copies to the nurses. The nurses will submit to the superintendent.
10. If a student refuses to wear a mask, they will be placed on the discipline ladder:
 - a. 1st offense: will be given a mask to wear
 - b. 2nd offense: will be asked to leave the premises
 - c. 3rd offense: will not be allowed back until compliant due to repeated noncompliance
11. If an employee refuses to wear a mask:
 - a. 1st offense: will be given a mask to wear
 - b. 2nd offense: will be asked to leave the premises and will forfeit pay for the day
 - c. 3rd offense: employment in jeopardy
12. Open House, August 5, 2021
 - a. Parents will be required to use hand sanitizer upon entering the building and classroom.
 - b. 3 parents will be allowed in a classroom at a time. Everyone else will wait outside of the room, socially distanced.
13. Positive cases
 - a. Principal/administrator is to be notified immediately.
 - b. Principal will notify nurses immediately.
 - c. Accurate and up to date COVID information will be posted on the district webpage.
 - d. Quarantine appropriately according to CDC guidelines
 - e. School nurses will maintain an accurate list of vaccinated students and staff on campus.
